The Arnold Center a not for profit community rehabilitation agency is announcing a hard drive destruction service to the general public and commercial customers designed to reduce / eliminate the risk of data breeches due to old unwanted technology that has been reclaimed and has personnel data on it.

How many older personal computers, laptops, i-pads or phones do you own that are stored in your basement or garage that you would like to dispose of without the risk of someone finding your personal data during recycling.

The Arnold Center is now offering a destruction service that will certify that these data files have been destroyed and safely recycled for the general public as well as commercial customers.

Thanks, to a generous grant from the Charles J. Strosacker Foundation, it has purchased a industrial grade hard drive shredder and is providing shredding services for individuals in the community as a drop off option and will negotiate with companies for possible options and services beyond drop off.

Certificates of Destruction are available. This service offering complements its current office paper shredding program that also supports the general public and commercial clients as well.
